The School Principal will be responsible for coordinating the development and recommendation of Partnerships at the school level. The Associate Superintendent of Education and the Communications Manager will be responsible for coordinating the development and approval of Partnerships at the district level. Final approval of the partnership is at the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools or designee. 2. Any partnership established must mutually benefit the students, families, district and the business 3. Partnerships may include but are not limited to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Direct student activities b. Enrichment of instruction c. Support to staff d. Auxiliary support to students e. Support of Curriculum f. Site and equipment maintenance modernization and/or beautification 4. No partnership will be approved whose program/participation furthers a secular and/or religious interest 5. Any person or organization whose purpose, social values, and/or public image are not supportive of the District's mission or goals will not be approved for partnership 6. Any publication of partnership activities to the community at-large will comply with the district's Advertising and Distributing Materials in Schools Provided by Non-School Related Entities; Policy 8:25 and Administrative Procedure 8:25-AP-1 7. Partnership programs will not limit the discretion of schools and teachers in the use of any sponsored materials 8. Any potential partnership will be written utilizing the School District 50 Partnership Form and will include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Mission of the partnership b. Written goal(s) of the partnership c. Description of the mutual benefit for both parties d. Implementation and Strategies 9. Results of the partnership should have measurable outcomes for the business, district, staff and/or students. 10. Both parties will evaluate the partnership on an annual basis.
