Resignations

Summary: A teacher may not resign during the school year in order to accept another teaching position without the consent of the Superintendent or designee.

Teachers may resign at any time with consent of the Superintendent or designee by written notice sent least 30 calendar days before the intended date of resignation. However, no teacher may resign during the school term in order to accept another teaching position without the consent of the Board.
