Student Support Services

Summary: The District may provide the following student support services: health services, educational and psychological testing services, and social worker services.

The following student support services are provided by the School District:

School nursing and/or school health services provided or supervised by a qualified nurse as permitted by law. The Superintendent or designee implements procedures to further a healthy school environment and prevent or reduce the spread of disease.

Educational and psychological testing services and the services of a psychologist as needed. In all cases, written permission to administer a psychological examination must be obtained from a student's parent(s)/guardian(s). The results will be given to the parent(s)/guardian(s), with interpretation, as well as to the appropriate professional staff.

The services of a social worker as needed. Consent must be obtained from a student's parent/guardian to receive regular or continuing services from a social worker.

A liaison to facilitate the enrollment and transfer of records of students in the legal custody of the Illinois Department of Children and Family services when enrolling in or changing schools.

The district shall teach and assess students' social and emotional skills and develop protocols for responding to students with social, emotional, or mental health problems that impact learning ability. The District, however, assumes no liability for preventing, identifying, or treating such problems.

This policy shall be implemented in a manner consistent with State and federal laws, including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 42 U.S.C. §1201 et seq.
